TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has ordered under section 17(1)(a) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) ('the Ordinance'):—

- (i) to close permanently sections of the existing carriageways (including central reserves/ refuge islands), footpaths and footbridges within the limit of works area as shown on Plans Nos. 255228/GZP/1000 to 255228/GZP/1013 ('the Plans') and described in the scheme annexed thereto, as amended by Amendment Plans Nos. 255228/GZP/1000A, 255228/GZP/1002Å, 255228/GZP/1004A, 255228/GZP/1007A, 255228/GZP/1001A, 255228/GZP/1010A and 255228/GZP/1012A ('the Amendment 255228/GZP/1008A, Plans') and described in the amendment scheme annexed thereto. The Plans listed under this subparagraph and scheme were referred to in G.N. 7025 published on 12 November 2010 and 19 November 2010. The Amendment Plans listed under this subparagraph and amendment scheme were referred to in G.N. 5861 published on 9 September 2011 and 16 September 2011. The Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has further declared under section 17(1)(c) of the Ordinance that as from 26 June 2016, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the sections of the existing carriageways (including central reserves/refuge islands), footpaths and footbridges to be permanently closed shall be extinguished; and
- (ii) to close temporarily sections of the existing carriageways (including central reserves/refuge islands), footpaths and footbridges within the limit of works area as shown on Plans Nos. 255228/GZP/1000 to 255228/GZP/1017 ('the Plans') and described in the scheme annexed thereto, as amended by Amendment Plans Nos. 255228/GZP/1000A, 255228/GZP/1001A, 255228/GZP/1004A, 255228/GZP/1007A, 255228/GZP/1008A, 255228/GZP/1002A, 255228/GZP/1010A, 255228/GZP/1012A. 255228/GZP/1014A, 255228/GZP/1015A, 255228/GZP/1016A and 255228/GZP/1017A ('the Amendment Plans') and described in the amendment scheme annexed thereto. The Plans listed under this subparagraph and scheme were referred to in G.N. 7025 published on 12 November 2010 and 19 November 2010. The Amendment Plans listed under this subparagraph and amendment scheme were referred to in G.N. 5861 published on 9 September 2011 and 16 September 2011. The Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has further declared under section 17(1)(c) of the Ordinance that from 26 June 2016 to 25 June 2017, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the sections of the existing carriageways (including central reserves/refuge islands), footpaths and footbridges to be temporarily closed, shall be extinguished, modified or restricted, as the case may be, during that period.

The works to be carried out in association with this closure mainly involve site formation, construction of carriageways, footpaths, landscaping areas and other ancillary works.
