

PHARMACY AND POISONS ORDINANCE (Chapter 138)

DIRECTION MADE BY THE DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE
OF THE PHARMACY AND POISONS BOARD OF HONG KONG

It is hereby notified that a Disciplinary Committee appointed by the Pharmacy and Poisons Board of Hong Kong under section 15 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance, Chapter 138, Laws of Hong Kong ('the Ordinance') to inquire into the conduct of an authorized seller of poisons, namely On Hing Pharmacy, at Shop C2, Ground Floor, Tung Tai Building, 118–124 Shau Kei Wan Main Street East, Shau Kei Wan, Hong Kong, has conducted an inquiry on 5 May 2016 in accordance with section 16 of the Ordinance.

The said Committee was satisfied after the inquiry that On Hing Pharmacy had been guilty of misconduct in that at the material time, On Hing Pharmacy, an authorized seller of poisons, was convicted of the following offences under the Trade Descriptions Ordinance, Chapter 362, Laws of Hong Kong, and the Ordinance, on 25 August 2015 at Eastern Magistrates' Courts, for which the following penalties were imposed on 18 September 2015:—

It is further notified that under section 16(2)(b) of the Ordinance, the said Committee directed that On Hing Pharmacy should be disqualified from being an authorized seller of poisons for a period of 3 days with effect from 17 June 2016. The said Committee added that its direction should be published in the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Gazette with an account of the proceedings.
