ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN NORTH POINT

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 17 June 2016, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones from 7.00 a.m. to 7.00 p.m. daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of Braemar Hill Road from a point about 65 metres west of its eastern end to a point about 25 metres west of the same end;
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Braemar Hill Road from a point about 55 metres west of its eastern end to a point about 65 metres west of the same end; and
- (c) the western kerbside lane of the access road leading to Braemar Hill Mansions from a point about 10 metres south of its eastern junction with Braemar Hill Road to the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
