2. In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 26 of the Buildings Ordinance, I HEREBY DECLARE that such building is dangerous and I HEREBY ORDER you as owner to carry out the following works and such works are to be commenced by 23 July 2016 and to be completed by 23 August 2016:

For the approved canopy at 1/F:

- (a) Remove loose, cracked and otherwise defective concrete from the reinforced concrete structure of the building, clean existing exposed steel bars of loose rust and foreign matters, provide and securely fix in place additional steel bars as necessary and reinstate.
- (b) Remove all loose/defective rendering.

All works specified in this order shall be carried out to such standard acceptable to the Building Authority and in compliance with the regulations.

Adequate precautionary measures to ensure public safety should be provided prior to and during the course of works.
