ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES IN TIN HAU

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 6.00 p.m. on 14 July 2016 to 6.00 p.m. on 27 July 2016, the following road sections will continue to be temporarily designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of Lau Li Street from a point about 20 metres east of its junction with Electric Road to a point about 45 metres east of the same junction (except the on-street parking space);
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Lau Li Street from a point about 20 metres east of its junction with Electric Road to a point about 55 metres east of the same junction; and
- (c) the western kerbside lane of Ngan Mok Street from its junction with Lau Li Street to a point about 45 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones have been indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will continue to be temporarily rescinded.
