The Amendment Plan and the amendment scheme were referred to in G.N. 7060 published on 29 November 2013 and 6 December 2013. The Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has further declared under section 17(1)(c) of the Ordinance that from 31 July 2016 to 30 July 2017, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the sections of the existing carriageways and footpaths/tracks to be temporarily closed, shall be exiting using the case may be, during that period.

The works to be carried out in association with this closure mainly involve the widening of Yiu Sha Road, realignment of an access road, construction of a footbridge and ancillary works.
