Notice is hereby given that under powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing under section 3(3) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370), the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes to execute the road works within the limit of works area as shown on Plan No. LW 9731 ('the Plan') and described in the scheme annexed thereto, which the Plan and scheme have been deposited in the Land Registry.
