

ROADS (WORKS, USE AND COMPENSATION) ORDINANCE (Chapter 370)
(Notice under section 18)

PROPOSED ROAD IMPROVEMENT WORKS IN
WEST KOWLOON RECLAMATION DEVELOPMENT

TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has ordered under section 17(1)(a) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) ('the Ordinance') to close temporarily sections of the existing at grade carriageways, elevated carriageways, footpaths, subway staircase, central medians/refuge islands and amenity areas within the limit of works area as shown on Plans Nos. CE44/K/GAZ/1000 to CE44/K/GAZ/1011 ('the Plans') and described in the scheme annexed thereto. The Plans and scheme were referred to in G.N. 1799 published on 5 April 2013 and 12 April 2013. The Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has further declared under section 17(1)(c) of the Ordinance that from 22 August 2016 to 21 August 2017, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the sections of the existing at grade carriageways, elevated carriageways, footpaths, subway staircase, central medians/refuge islands and amenity areas to be temporarily closed, shall be extinguished, modified or restricted, as the case may be, during that period.

The works to be carried out in association with this closure mainly involve:—

- (i) construction of an at grade single lane carriageway as a slip road connecting West Kowloon Highway southbound to Nga Cheung Road;
- (ii) construction of an elevated single lane carriageway connecting the elevated Nga Cheung Road to the Western Harbour Crossing toll plaza area;
- (iii) construction of an elevated single lane carriageway connecting Hoi Po Road to West Kowloon Highway northbound;
- (iv) realignment of a section of Lin Cheung Road northbound and a section of Hoi Fai Road;
- (v) road junction improvement works at a junction of Canton Road, Austin Road and Austin Road West, a junction of Canton Road and Wui Cheung Road as well as a junction of Canton Road, Jordan Road and Ferry Street; and
- (vi) ancillary works including landscaping, drainage and utilities works.

This notice will be affixed on or near the affected at grade carriageways, elevated carriageways, footpaths, subway staircase, central medians/refuge islands and amenity areas on 12 August 2016.

Any person entitled to compensation under the Ordinance may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing, 22nd Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong, before the expiration of one year from the date of closure.

Personal Information Collection Statement

Any information, including the personal data, submitted to the Secretary for Transport and Housing in connection with any written claims served under section 29 of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) will be used for the processing of the claims and other related purposes. The provision of the information, including the personal data, as required under section 29 of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) is obligatory. If such information, including the personal data, as required under section 29 of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) is not provided as requested, the claims may be rejected. Any information, including the personal data, so submitted may be disclosed to the relevant government departments and other organizations or agencies which are required to handle the claims and related matters. Persons who have so submitted their personal data have the rights to request access to and correction of their personal data held by us.
