

ROADS (WORKS, USE AND COMPENSATION) ORDINANCE (Chapter 370)

(Notice under section 18)

TSEUNG KWAN O—LAM TIN TUNNEL

TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has ordered under sections 17(1)(a) and 17(1)(b) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) ('the Ordinance') to close permanently sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths, cycle tracks and central reserves/refuge islands; and to close temporarily sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths, cycle tracks, central reserves/refuge islands, amenity areas and open space, as well as to reclaim the Government foreshore and sea-bed within the limit of works area as shown on Plans Nos. TK2377 to TK2385 ('the Plans') and described in the scheme annexed thereto. The Plans and scheme were referred to in G.N. 2569 published on 10 May 2013 and 16 May 2013. The Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has further declared under section 17(1)(c) of the Ordinance that as from 15 August 2016, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths, cycle tracks and central reserves/refuge islands to be permanently closed, shall be extinguished; from 15 August 2016 to 14 August 2017, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths, cycle tracks, central reserves/refuge islands, amenity areas and open space to be temporarily closed, shall be extinguished, modified or restricted, as the case may be, during that period; and as from 15 August 2016, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the Government foreshore and sea-bed to be reclaimed, shall be extinguished.

The works to be carried out in association with this closure mainly involve the construction of a dual two-lane highway (of which part is in the form of a tunnel) between Lam Tin and Tseung Kwan O South, and the construction of slip roads, depressed Road P2, Lam Tin Interchange and Tseung Kwan O Interchange, as well as other ancillary works.

The works to be carried out in association with this reclamation mainly involve reclamation of approximately 3 hectares of Government foreshore and sea-bed at Junk Bay for the construction of a section of the Road P2 and associated road works.

This notice will be affixed on or near the affected carriageways, footpaths, cycle tracks, central reserves/refuge islands, amenity areas and open space, as well as the Government foreshore and sea-bed on 12 August 2016.

Any person entitled to compensation under the Ordinance may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing, 22nd Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong, before the expiration of one year from the date of closure or extinction.

Personal Information Collection Statement

Any information, including the personal data, submitted to the Secretary for Transport and Housing in connection with any written claims served under section 29 of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) will be used for the processing of the claims and other related purposes. The provision of the information, including the personal data, as required under section 29 of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) is obligatory. If such information, including the personal data, as required under section 29 of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) is not provided as requested, the claims may be rejected. Any information, including the personal data, so submitted may be disclosed to the relevant government departments and other organizations or agencies which are required to handle the claims and related matters. Persons who have so submitted their personal data have the rights to request access to and correction of their personal data held by us.
