TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has ordered under section 17(1)(a) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) ('the Ordinance') to close temporarily sections of the existing carriageways and a section of the existing footpath at Tai Ho Road, a section of the existing carriageway leading to the former Tsuen Wan Transport Complex, and a section of the existing carriageway and sections of the existing footpaths at Hoi Kwai Road within the limit of works area as shown on Plan No. RDM0558 ('the Plan') and described in the scheme annexed thereto, and as amended by Amendment Plan No. RDM0558a ('the Amendment Plan') and described in the amendment scheme annexed thereto. The Plan and scheme were referred to in G.N. 8694 published on 24 December 2008 and 2 January 2009. The Amendment Plan and amendment scheme were referred to in G.N. 4630 published on 22 July 2011 and 29 July 2011. The Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has further declared under section 17(1)(c) of the Ordinance that from 24 August 2016 to 23 August 2017, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the sections of the existing carriageways and footpaths to be temporarily closed, shall be extinguished, modified or restricted, as the case may be, during that period.

The works to be carried out in association with this closure mainly involve the road works for the future West Rail Tsuen Wan West Station TW5 Property Development.

Any person entitled to compensation under the Ordinance may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing, 22nd Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong, before the expiration of one year from the date of closure.
