

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES IN KOWLOON CITY

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 12 August 2016 to 31 October 2016, the following road sections in Kowloon City will continue to be temporarily designated restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of Prince Edward Road West eastbound from its junction with Waterloo Road to a point about 140 metres west of the same junction; and
- (b) the section of Waterloo Road northbound from its junction with Prince Edward Road West to a point about 50 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones have been indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will continue to be temporarily rescinded.
