

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN NORTH POINT

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 12 August 2016, the following road sections will be designated restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of Tsat Tsz Mui Road from its junction with Kam Hong Street to a point about 20 metres west of the same junction;
- (b) the western kerbside lane of Kam Hong Street from a point about 40 metres north of its junction with Tanner Road to the same junction;
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of Kam Hong Street from a point about 30 metres north of its junction with Tanner Road to the same junction;
- (d) the northern kerbside lane of Tanner Road from a point about 5 metres west of its junction with Kam Hong Street to the same junction; and
- (e) the northern kerbside lane of Tanner Road from a point about 30 metres east of its junction with Kam Hong Street to the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
