

It is hereby notified that tenders are invited for the **provision of services for elderly persons (the Services) at 3/F and 4/F, Ancillary Facilities Block, Tin Yan Estate, Tin Shui Wai, New Territories (Premises of Tin Yan Estate)**. The Services include providing a maximum number of 106 residential care places, 27 subsidised day care places and 4 obligatory day respite care places in the Premises of Tin Yan Estate (Tender Reference: SWD1/5G(2)/872/2016(2)).

A tender must be placed and sealed in two separate envelopes. The 'Offer to be Bound', the 'Technical Proposal' and the 'Financial Information Submission' must be placed and sealed in one envelope while the 'Volume Proposal' must be placed and sealed in another envelope.

Tenders must be clearly marked with the tender reference and the subject of the tender on the outside of the envelopes (but should not bear any indication which may relate the tender to the tenderer), addressed to the Chairman, Central Tender Board, and be deposited in the Government Logistics Department Tender Box located on the Ground Floor, North Point Government Offices, 333 Java Road, North Point, Hong Kong before 12.00 noon (Hong Kong time) on 23 September 2016 (Friday). Late tenders will not be accepted.
