

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONE IN
YUK WAH STREET, WONG TAI SIN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 1 October 2016 to 12 February 2017, the southern kerbside lane of Yuk Wah Street from a point about 15 metres east of its junction with Wan Wah Street to a point about 25 metres east of the same junction will continue to be temporarily designated a restricted zone 24 hours daily to facilitate the construction of Shatin to Central Link.

Within the restricted zone, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses, public light buses (scheduled services) and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zone has been indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zone on the above road section will continue to be temporarily rescinded.
