

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES IN TAI YIP STREET,
KWUN TONG

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 1 October 2016 to 14 October 2016, the following road sections in Tai Yip Street will continue to be temporarily designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of Tai Yip Street from its junction with Hong Tak Road to a point about 65 metres south of the same junction; and
- (b) the section of Tai Yip Street from a point about 175 metres south of its junction with Hong Tak Road to a point about 205 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones has been indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will continue to be temporarily rescinded.
