

It is hereby notified that sealed tenders in duplicate are invited for **Contract No. HY/2016/06—Lift and Pedestrian Walkway System at Cheung Hang Estate, Tsing Yi (Public Works Programme Item No. 169TB)**. The works mainly comprise:—

- (a) construction of a lift tower with two lifts and staircase of about 31 metres (m) in height at Tsing Yu Street;
- (b) construction of a covered elevated walkway with a clear width of about 3.3 m and of about 60 m in length, connecting the above lift tower to the footpath along the southbound carriageway of Tsing Yi Road West;
- (c) construction of a lift tower with single lift of about 13 m in height at the eastern side of the existing footbridge (No. NF230) across Tsing Yi Road West;
- (d) widening of a section of footpath of about 30 m in length to about 3.5 m along the southbound carriageway of Tsing Yi Road West between the proposed elevated walkway and the existing footbridge (No. NF230) across Tsing Yi Road West; and
- (e) ancillary works, including associated road, drainage, slope and geotechnical, utilities, public lighting, landscaping, electrical and mechanical (E&M) works, etc.

The works are scheduled to commence in January 2017 and will take about 30 months to complete.

Tenders must be clearly marked with the tender reference and the subject of the tender on the outside of the envelope (but should not bear any indication which may relate the tender to the tenderer) addressed to the Chairman, Central Tender Board and placed in the Government Logistics Department Tender Box situated on the Ground Floor, North Point Government Offices, 333 Java Road, North Point, Hong Kong, before 12.00 noon on Friday, 11 November 2016. Late tenders will not be accepted. If a black rainstorm warning signal or tropical cyclone warning signal No. 8 or above is in effect at any time between 9.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon on Friday, 11 November 2016, the tender closing time will be postponed to 12.00 noon on the first working day after the black rainstorm warning signal has ceased to be in effect or the tropical cyclone warning signal No. 8 is lowered. An announcement of the change will be made through the radio.

Selective tendering is adopted. Contractors on the List of Approved Contractors for Public Works in Group B for Roads and Drainage Category (confirmed) or joint ventures with participation of local and/or overseas contractors with the lead participant or the major shareholder being on the List of Approved Contractors for Public Works in Group B for Roads and Drainage Category (confirmed) who also meet the qualifications and conditions for participation stipulated in the tender documents are invited to tender.

Contractors not yet on the List of Approved Contractors for Public Works in Group B for Roads and Drainage Category (confirmed) may also submit a tender if they submit a request for participation together with a duly completed application for inclusion in the above-mentioned approved list/category by 25 October 2016 to Chief Highway Engineer/Works, Works Division, Highways Department at 7th Floor, Trade and Industry Tower, 3 Concorde Road, Kowloon, Hong Kong, meet the qualifications and conditions for participation, and the application for inclusion is duly approved on or before the tender closing date.
