Religious subsector nomination forms may be obtained free of charge during ordinary business hours on any day other than a general holiday from the offices of the Registration and Electoral Office at 10/F, Harbour Centre, 25 Harbour Road, Wan Chai, Hong Kong or Unit 2301-2303, 23/F, Millenium City 6, 392 Kwun Tong Road, Kwun Tong, or from the office of the Returning Officer for the religious subsector at the above address, or can be downloaded from the website of the Registration and Electoral Office (<http://www.reo.gov.hk>).
