ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN NORTH POINT

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 21 October 2016, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the southern kerbside lane of Tsat Tsz Mui Road from a point about 45 metres east of its junction with Tin Chiu Street to the same junction;
- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of Tin Chiu Street from a point about 35 metres south of its junction with Tsat Tsz Mui Road to the same junction;
- (c) the western kerbside lane of Kai Yuen Street from a point about 10 metres south of its junction with Tanner Road to the same junction; and
- (d) the southern kerbside lane of Tanner Road from a point about 5 metres west of its junction with Kai Yuen Street to the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be temporarily rescinded.
