Commence and Continue to Operate : The purchaser shall open and commence to operate the petrol filling station on or before 30 September 2018  
Annual Rental : An amount equal to 3% of the rateable value from time to time of the lot  
Lease Term : A term of 21 years commencing from the date of Memorandum of Agreement  
User : (i) Petrol filling station including facilities for the supply of liquefied petroleum gas to motor vehicles but excluding any vehicle servicing or lubricating facilities; and

Commence and Continue to Operate : The purchaser shall open and commence to operate the petrol filling station on or before 31 March 2019  
Annual Rental : An amount equal to 3% of the rateable value from time to time of the lot  
Lease Term : A term of 21 years commencing from the date of Memorandum of Agreement  
User : (i) Petrol filling station including facilities for the supply of liquefied petroleum gas to motor vehicles but excluding any vehicle servicing or lubricating facilities; and  
(ii) Retail sale and storage ancillary to the retail sale purposes only

Prospective tenderers are advised that tenders can be submitted in either one or both of the following ways:—

- (i) individually, for either of the two lots; and/or  
(ii) on the basis of a single amount of tender premium for the purchase of both lots together as one package.

If prospective tenderers intend to submit tenders for either of the two lots on an individual basis, they should complete, in duplicate, the respective Form of Tender (A) annexed to the Tender Notices. Tenders must be clearly marked with 'Tender for (please fill in the Lot Number)' on the outside of the envelope (but should not bear any indication which may relate the tender to the tenderer) addressed to the Chairman, Central Tender Board.

If prospective tenderers intend to submit tenders for both lots together as one package, they should complete, in duplicate, the Form of Tender (B) annexed to the Tender Notices. Tenders must be clearly marked with 'Tender for Kowloon Inland Lot No. 11261 and New Kowloon Inland Lot No. 6570' on the outside of the envelope (but should not bear any indication which may relate the tender to the tenderer) addressed to the Chairman, Central Tender Board.

An Explanatory Statement has been issued and is attached to the tender documents for information and guidance of the prospective tenderers.

Tenders should be enclosed in a sealed envelope and must be placed in the Government Logistics Department Tender Box situated at the Ground Floor, North Point Government Offices, 333 Java Road, North Point, Hong Kong before 12.00 noon on Friday, 16 December 2016. Late tenders will not be accepted.

Prospective tenderers are requested to note that Lands Department will only answer questions of a general nature concerning the above lots and will not provide legal or other advice in respect of the Conditions of Sale or statutory provisions relating to the lots.
