The Plan and scheme were referred to in G.N. 471 published under section 8(2) of the Ordinance on 29 January 2016 and 5 February 2016. The proposed amendments are shown on Amendment Plan No. KZ1029A ('the Amendment Plan') and described in the amendment scheme annexed thereto, which the Amendment Plan and amendment scheme have been deposited in the Land Registry.

The general nature of the proposed amendments is as follows:----

- (i) revision of the originally proposed limit of works area;
- (ii) revision of the location and layout of parts of the originally proposed covered footbridge, lifts, lift tower, covered staircase and staircase structure;
- (iii) deletion of the originally proposed demolition and conversion of a section of the existing planter into footpath and replaced by temporary demolition and reconstruction of a section of the existing planter;
- (iv) deletion of the originally proposed permanent closure and conversion of a section of the existing footpath into lift tower and replaced by temporary closure and reconstruction of a section of the existing footpath;
- (v) deletion of the originally proposed permanent closure and conversion of a section of the existing footpath into staircase/escalator structure and replaced by temporary closure and reconstruction of a section of the existing footpath;
- (vi) deletion of the originally proposed permanent closure and conversion of a section of the existing footpath into planter and replaced by temporary closure and reconstruction of a section of the existing footpath;
- (vii) deletion of the originally proposed demolition and conversion of a section of the existing planter into lift tower and replaced by temporary demolition and reconstruction of a section of the existing planter;
- (viii) temporary closure of sections of the existing carriageways and footpaths; and
- (ix) revision of the proposed ancillary works including drainage, water, electrical and mechanical, and landscaping works.
