WIDENING OF TOLO HIGHWAY/FANLING HIGHWAY
BETWEEN ISLAND HOUSE INTERCHANGE AND FANLING—STAGE 2

TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has ordered under section 17(1)(a) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) ('the Ordinance') to close permanently the existing Pedestrian and Cycle Bridge at Wo Hop Shek within the limit of works area as shown on Plan No. HyD/TFH/GZ/012 ('the Plan') and described in the scheme annexed thereto, and as amended by Amendment Plan No. HyD/TFH/GZ/012A ('the Amendment Plan') and described in the amendment scheme annexed thereto, and as modified by Modification Plan No. HyD/TFH/GZ/011B ('the Modification Plan'). The Plan and scheme were referred to in G.N. 4060 published on 3 July 2009 and 10 July 2009. The Amendment Plan and amendment scheme were referred to in G.N. 3004 published on 28 May 2010 and 4 June 2010. The Modification Plan was referred to in G.N. 4890 published on 29 July 2011 and 5 August 2011. The Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has further declared under section 17(1)(c) of the Ordinance that as from 26 November 2016, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the existing Pedestrian and Cycle Bridge at Wo Hop Shek to be permanently closed, shall be extinguished.

The works to be carried out in association with this closure mainly involve the permanent closure and demolition of the existing Pedestrian and Cycle Bridge at Wo Hop Shek.

This notice will be affixed on or near the affected existing Pedestrian and Cycle Bridge at Wo Hop Shek on 25 November 2016.

Any person entitled to compensation under the Ordinance may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing, 22nd Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong, before the expiration of one year from the date of closure.
