ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES IN TAI KOK TSUL

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 29 November 2016 to 13 December 2016, the following road sections in Tai Kok Tsui will be temporarily designated restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of Maple Street from its junction with Sycamore Street to a point about 35 metres north of the same junction; and
- (b) the northern kerbside lane of Sycamore Street from its junction with Maple Street to a point about 25 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
