## ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

## RESTRICTED ZONES IN TAI KOK TSUI

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 25 November 2016, the following road sections in Tai Kok Tsui will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of Ivy Street from a point about 15 metres east of its junction with Pine Street to a point about 15 metres west of the same junction; and
- (b) the section of Pine Street from a point about 5 metres south of its junction with Ivy Street to a point about 5 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
