

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES IN SAN PO KONG

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 1 December 2016 to 31 January 2017, the following road sections in San Po Kong will continue to be temporarily designated restricted zones during the time periods specified below:—

(A) *from 7.00 a.m. to 7.00 p.m. daily*

the northern kerbside lane of Tsat Po Street from its junction with Sam Chuk Street to a point about 50 metres east of the same junction.

(B) *from 7.00 a.m. to 12.00 midnight daily*

the southern kerbside lane of Tsat Po Street.

(C) *24 hours daily*

the section of King Fuk Street from a point about 5 metres east of its junction with Sam Chuk Street to a point about 65 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

(a) picking up or setting down passengers; or

(b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones have been indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
