

ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON CONDUIT ROAD, MID-LEVELS

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 25 November 2016, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones from 8.00 a.m. to 10.00 a.m. and from 5.00 p.m. to 7.00 p.m. daily:—

- (a) the southern kerbside lane of Conduit Road from a point about 135 metres west of its junction with Castle Road to a point about 145 metres west of the same junction;
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Conduit Road from a point about 155 metres west of its junction with Castle Road to a point about 240 metres west of the same junction; and
- (c) the northern kerbside lane of Conduit Road from a point about 130 metres west of its junction with Castle Road to a point about 230 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
