For the soffit of the approved balcony on 1/F and external walls of the building only:

- remove loose, cracked, defective concrete, clean exposed rusty steel bars, replace or add steel bars as necessary, and reinstate with new concrete; and
- (ii) remove all loose, defective rendering and plastering.

All works specified in this order shall be carried out to such standard acceptable to the Building Authority and in compliance with the regulations.
