

It is hereby notified that tenders are invited for the **provision of Dead/Debilited/Trapped Bird Collection and Delivery services within the territories of Hong Kong in an effective and efficient manner on a 24-hour round the clock and seven days a week basis (Tender Reference: AFCD/IQ/AH/01/16)**. This is a two-year service contract which is expected to commence on 1 April 2017.
