

ROADS (WORKS, USE AND COMPENSATION) ORDINANCE (Chapter 370)

TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has ordered under section 17(1)(b) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) ('the Ordinance') to reclaim the Government foreshore and/or sea-bed within the limit of works area as shown on Plan No. 60044963/GAZ/1003 ('the Plan') and described in the scheme annexed thereto. The Plan and scheme were referred to in G.N. 5157 published on 21 August 2009 and 28 August 2009. The Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has further declared under section 17(1)(c) of the Ordinance that as from 27 December 2016, all public or private rights over the Government foreshore and/or sea-bed to be affected or reclaimed within Zone 1b as shown on Plan No. HZM6825TH-SK0217 shall be extinguished.

The works to be carried out in association with this reclamation mainly involve (i) construction of seawall; (ii) reclamation of the Government foreshore and/or sea-bed at Tuen Mun, (iii) construction of carriageways, footpaths, and central reserves/refuge islands; (iv) construction of an administration building and other ancillary buildings/facilities; and (v) ancillary works including drainage, sewerage, water supplies, utilities, and electrical and mechanical works.

Any person entitled to compensation under the Ordinance may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing, 22nd Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong before the expiration of one year from the date of extinction.
