ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

PROHIBITED ZONE FOR VEHICLES EXCEEDING 7 METRES IN LENGTH IN WONG CHUK HANG

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 6.00 a.m. on 28 December 2016, the u-turn slip road connecting Wong Chuk Hang Road northbound to Wong Chuk Hang Road southbound, which is about 53 metres south of the junction of Wong Chuk Hang Road and Shouson Hill Road, will be designated as a prohibited zone 24 hours daily for all motor vehicles exceeding 7 metres in length.

Drivers of all motor vehicles, except those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from driving vehicles exceeding 7 metres in length into the prohibited zone.

The extent of prohibited zone will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs.
