## ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

## RESTRICTED ZONES ON WONG TAI SIN ROAD, WONG TAI SIN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 23 December 2016, the following road sections will be designated restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the southern kerbside lane of Wong Tai Sin Road from a point about 15 metres west of its junction with Nga Chuk Street to a point about 40 metres west of the same junction;
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Wong Tai Sin Road from a point about 40 metres west of its junction with Nga Chuk Street to a point about 75 metres west of the same junction; and
- (c) the southern kerbside lane of Wong Tai Sin Road from a point about 75 metres west of its junction with Nga Chuk Street to a point about 115 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones in (a) and (c) above, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

Within the restricted zone in (b) above, drivers of all motor vehicles, except private cars, taxis, buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
