

It is hereby notified that sealed tenders are invited for **Contract No.: EP/SP/86/15—Organic waste treatment facilities phase 2 (Public Works Programme Item No. 5173DR)**.

The scope of the Contract comprises design, construction, operation and maintenance of the Organic Waste Treatment Facilities Phase 2 (OWTF) located at Sha Ling of North District in Hong Kong Special Administrative Region to convert source-separated organic waste into biogas and compost using biological treatment technologies. This Contract is scheduled to commence in July 2018 with design, construction, testing and commissioning works completed in March 2021. Apart from the design and construction works, the contract includes operation and maintenance of the OWTF for a period of 15 years.

Tenders must be clearly marked with the tender reference and the subject of the tender on the outside of the envelope (but should not bear any indication which may relate the tender to the tenderer) addressed to the Chairman, Central Tender Board, and placed in the Government Logistics Department Tender Box situated at the Ground Floor, North Point Government Offices, 333 Java Road, North Point, Hong Kong, before 12.00 noon on Friday, 26 May 2017. Late tenders will not be accepted.

In the event a tropical cyclone warning signal No. 8 or above or a black rainstorm warning signal is in force between 9.00 a.m. and 12.00 noon on Friday, 26 May 2017, the tender closing time will be postponed to 12.00 noon on the first working day of the following week. An announcement of the change will be made through radio.

Tenderers shall satisfy the requirements stated in the tender documents.

This tender is covered by the Agreement on Government Procurement of the World Trade Organization and will not involve electronic auction. This notice also serves as a summary notice required under the Agreement on Government Procurement of the World Trade Organization.

A charge will be levied for the delivery of the tender documents where the delivery of such documents is requested by a tenderer. A written request must be made.
