ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN TAK HOI STREET, TSUEN WAN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 6 January 2017, the following road sections in Tsuen Wan will be designated as restricted zones from 7.00 a.m. to 7.00 p.m. daily:—

- (a) the eastern kerbside lane of Tak Hoi Street from a point about 120 metres south of its junction with Tsuen Wan Market Street to a point about 135 metres south of the same junction; and
- (b) the northern kerbside lane of Tak Hoi Street from a point about 50 metres west of its junction with Ham Tin Street to a point about 65 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses at designated bus stops and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
