

PHARMACY AND POISONS ORDINANCE (Chapter 138)

DIRECTION MADE BY THE DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE
OF THE PHARMACY AND POISONS BOARD OF HONG KONG

It is hereby notified that a Disciplinary Committee appointed by the Pharmacy and Poisons Board of Hong Kong under section 15 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance, Chapter 138, Laws of Hong Kong (‘the Ordinance’) to inquire into the conduct of an authorized seller of poisons, namely Chi Man Dispensary O/B Sun Wing Medicine Company Limited, at Shop 6 and 53, Ground Floor, Wah Lok Mansion, 2 Tsing Shan Square, Tuen Mun, New Territories, has conducted an inquiry on 1 December 2016 in accordance with section 16 of the Ordinance.

The said Committee was satisfied after the inquiry that Chi Man Dispensary O/B Sun Wing Medicine Company Limited had been guilty of misconduct in that at the material time, Sun Wing Medicine Company Limited operating Chi Man Dispensary, an authorized seller of poisons, and its salesperson, Mr. CHEUNG Po-yuen, were convicted of the following offences under the Trade Descriptions Ordinance, Chapter 362, Laws of Hong Kong and the Ordinance, respectively, on 22 March 2016 at Tuen Mun Magistrates’ Courts for which the following penalties were imposed:—

It is further notified that under section 16(2)(b) of the Ordinance, the said Committee directed that Chi Man Dispensary O/B Sun Wing Medicine Company Limited should be disqualified from being an authorized seller of poisons for a period of 5 days with effect from 13 January 2017. The said Committee added that its direction should be published in the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Gazette with an account of the proceedings.
