SUPPLEMENTARY MEDICAL PROFESSIONS ORDINANCE (Chapter 359)

ORDER MADE BY THE OCCUPATIONAL THERAPISTS BOARD

The Occupational Therapists Board, after due inquiry held on 8 November 2016 in accordance with the Occupational Therapists (Registration and Disciplinary Procedure) Regulation (Chapter 359B), was satisfied that Mr. CHOI Ho-kwong (Registration No.: OT101591), being a registered occupational therapist (Part I) at Mercy Medirehab Professional Group Limited ('the Company'), has disregarded his professional responsibility to treat or care for his patients and neglected his professional duties and responsibility by improperly delegated to persons who are not registered occupational therapists duties or functions in connection with the treatment of patients for whom he was responsible, in that:—

- (a) During the period from 12 October 2015 to 30 October 2015, he may have disregarded his professional responsibility to treat or care for his patients; and
- (b) During the period from 12 October 2015 to 30 October 2015, he arranged two persons, who are not registered occupational therapists, to conduct visits to his patients.

and in relation to the facts alleged, either individually or cumulatively, he has been guilty of unprofessional conduct.

In accordance with section 22(1)(iii) of the Supplementary Medical Professions Ordinance (Chapter 359), the Occupational Therapists Board ordered on 8 November 2016 that Mr. CHOI Ho-kwong be reprimanded and such order shall be published in the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Gazette.
