ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN DAI CHEONG STREET AND DAI KWAI STREET, TAI PO

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 20 January 2017, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of Dai Cheong Street from its junction with Dai Kwai Street to a point about 15 metres west of the same junction; and
- (b) the western kerbside lane of Dai Kwai Street northbound from a point about 15 metres north of its junction with Dai Cheong Street to a point about 15 metres south of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
