ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN MA ON SHAN TOWN CENTRE

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 18 January 2017, the following sections of roads in Ma On Shan Town Centre will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the western kerbside lane of On Shing Street from its western junction with On Luk Street westbound to a point about 20 metres south of the same junction;
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of On Luk Street westbound from it western junction with On Shing Street to a point about 20 metres west of the same junction;
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of On Shing Street from its western junction with On Luk Street westbound to a point about 20 metres south of the same junction; and
- (d) the southern kerbside lane of On Luk Street westbound from its western junction with On Shing Street to a point about 40 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
