Notice is hereby given that under powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing under section 3(3) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370), the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes to execute the road works within the limit of works area as shown on Plan No. CE53/KF29/GZ/0001 ('the Plan') and described in the scheme annexed thereto, which the Plan and scheme have been deposited in the Land Registry.

The general nature of the proposed works is as follows:—

- (i) construction of three lifts at the existing footbridge No. KF29 across Kowloon City Road and San Shan Road in Kowloon City District;
- (ii) construction of elevated platforms and the associated columns to connect the proposed lifts in (i) with the existing footbridge No. KF29;
- (iii) construction of staircases;
- (iv) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing staircases into part of a proposed lift in (i), part of an elevated platform and the associated column in (ii) and footpaths;
- (v) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing footpaths into the proposed lifts in (i) and staircases in (iii);
- (vi) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing carriageways into footpaths;
- (vii) permanent closure and conversion of a section of the existing carriageway into a column in (ii);
- (viii) permanent closure and conversion of a section of the existing footpath into carriageway;
 - (ix) permanent closure and conversion of a section of the existing footpath into a column in (ii);
 - (x) temporary closure of sections of the existing carriageways and footpaths; and
- (xi) ancillary works including electrical and mechanical, drainage, lighting and landscaping works.
