ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES IN TSUEN WAN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 13 February 2017 to 6.00 p.m. on 14 May 2017, the following road sections in Tsuen Wan will be temporarily designated restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) both kerbside lanes of Sham Tseng Tsuen Road from its junction with the unnamed access road to Sham Tseng Kau Tsuen to a point about 40 metres west of the same junction;
- (b) the western kerbside lane of the unnamed access road to Sham Tseng Kau Tsuen from its junction with Sham Tseng Tsuen Road to a point about 25 metres north of the same junction;
- (c) the eastern kerbside lane of Sham Tseng Tsuen Road from its junction with Castle Peak Road—Sham Tseng to a point about 55 metres north of the same junction; and
- (d) the western kerbside lane of Sham Tseng Tsuen Road from a point about 5 metres north of its junction with Castle Peak Road—Sham Tseng to a point about 50 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
