PWP ITEM NO. 6810TH RETROFITTING OF NOISE BARRIERS ON TUEN MUN ROAD (TOWN CENTRE SECTION)

TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has ordered under section 17(1)(a) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) ('the Ordinance') to close temporarily sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths, central medians, verges, footbridges and vehicular bridge within the limit of works area as shown on Plans Nos. TMR/GZP/001, TMR/GZP/002 and TMR/GZP/003 ('the Plans') and described in the scheme annexed thereto, and as modified by Modification Plan No. HMW6810TH-SK0015 ('the Modification Plan'). The Plans and scheme were referred to in G.N. 6409 published on 28 September 2012 and 5 October 2012. The Modification Plan was referred to in G.N. 5715 published on 27 September 2013 and 4 October 2013. The Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) has further declared under section 17(1)(c) of the Ordinance that from 26 February 2017 to 25 February 2018, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths, central medians, verges, footbridges and vehicular bridge to be temporarily closed, shall be extinguished, modified or restricted, as the case may be, during that period.

The works to be carried out in association with this closure mainly involve installation of cantilever noise barriers, vertical noise barriers, a full enclosure and semi-enclosures along Tuen Mun Road between Rose Dale Garden and Lakeshore Building; widening and relocation of the existing bus lay-by on Tuen Mun Road Yuen Long bound near Lee Fat Path, and other ancillary works.

Any person entitled to compensation under the Ordinance may serve a written claim upon the Secretary for Transport and Housing, 22nd Floor, East Wing, Central Government Offices, 2 Tim Mei Avenue, Tamar, Hong Kong, before the expiration of one year from the date of closure.
