For common areas & the exterior of the building:

- (a) Remove loose cracked and otherwise defective concrete from the reinforced concrete structure of the building, clean existing exposed steel bars of loose rust and foreign matter, provide and securely fix in place additional steel bars as necessary and reinstate. The Building Authority shall be notified prior to placing of new concrete and the Building Authority may carry out audit checking in this regards.
- (b) Remove all loose or defective external rendering and internal plastering.

All works specified in this order shall be carried out to such standard acceptable to the Building Authority and in compliance with the regulations.
