ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES IN TAI KOK TSUL

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 21 February 2017 to 27 March 2017, the following road sections in Tai Kok Tsui will be temporarily designated restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of Ivy Street from a point about 10 metres east of its junction with Pine Street to a point about 30 metres east of the same junction; and
- (b) the section of Pine Street from a point about 5 metres north of its junction with Ivy Street to a point about 20 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
