ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES IN UPPER STATION STREET, SHEUNG WAN

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 17 March 2017, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the section of Upper Station Street from its junction with Tai Ping Shan Street to a point about 8 metres north of the same junction; and
- (b) the northern kerbside lane of Tai Ping Shan Street from a point about 7 metres east of its junction with Upper Station Street to a point about 8 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
