ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

RESTRICTED ZONES ON TIN HAU TEMPLE ROAD, TIN HAU

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 28 April 2017, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the western kerbside lane of Tin Hau Temple Road from a point about 30 metres north of its *cul-de-sac* outside Dragon Road Sitting-out Area to a point about 45 metres north of the same *cul-de-sac*: and
- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of Tin Hau Temple Road from a point about 35 metres north of its *cul-de-sac* outside Dragon Road Sitting-out Area to a point about 45 metres north of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
