## ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

## RESTRICTED ZONES IN TAI YIP LANE, KWUN TONG

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 19 May 2017, the following road sections in Tai Yip Lane will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of Tai Yip Lane from a point about 80 metres west of its junction with Tai Yip Street to a point about 100 metres west of the same junction; and
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Tai Yip Lane from a point about 80 metres west of its junction with Tai Yip Street to a point about 90 metres west of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
