

It is hereby notified that sealed tender in triplicate is invited for the **Provision of Cleansing and Supporting Services to Leisure Venues in Sham Shui Po and Yau Tsim Mong Districts of the Leisure and Cultural Services Department for a period of 36 months from 1 October 2017 to 30 September 2020 (Tender Ref.: LCT 7008/16(S)).**
