

MARINE PARKS ORDINANCE (Chapter 476)
(Section 8(1))

In accordance with section 7 of the Marine Parks Ordinance (Chapter 476) ('the Ordinance'), the Country and Marine Parks Authority has prepared a draft map (Plan No. MP/SWL) for the proposed Southwest Lantau Marine Park ('the Proposed Marine Park').

The Proposed Marine Park is located in the southwestern waters of Lantau and covers two sea areas of about 650 hectares. The seaward boundary of the Proposed Marine Park is shown in the draft map. The landward boundary will be demarcated with reference to the high water mark along the coastline of Peaked Hill and the Southwest Lantau.

Copies of the draft map, together with other information relating to the Proposed Marine Park, are available for inspection by the public free of charge at the following Government Offices for a period of sixty days from the date of publication of this notice during the following hours when these offices are normally open to the public:—

Any person may obtain a copy of the draft map upon payment of \$45 at the Agriculture, Fisheries and Conservation Department, 5th Floor, Cheung Sha Wan Government Offices, 303 Cheung Sha Wan Road, Kowloon.

In accordance with section 12 of the Ordinance, any person aggrieved by the draft map may within the period of sixty days from the date of publication of this notice send to the Country and Marine Parks Authority, 5th Floor, 303 Cheung Sha Wan Road, Kowloon, a written statement of his/her objection to the draft map. Such written statement shall set out:—

- (a) the nature of and reasons for the objection; and
- (b) if the objection would be removed by an alteration to the draft map, any alteration proposed.

Personal Information Collection Statement

Any information, including personal data, submitted to the Country and Marine Parks Authority in connection with any objections/comments will be used for the purpose of processing the objections/comments and other related purposes. The provision of any information, including personal data, is voluntary. However, it may not be possible to process the objections/comments if information, including personal data, is not sufficiently provided. Any information, including personal data, so submitted may be disclosed to the Country and Marine Parks Board, relevant government departments and other persons, organization or agencies which are required to handle the objections/comments and related matters. Persons who have so submitted their personal data have the rights to request access to, and correction of, their personal data held by the Country and Marine Parks Authority. Request for access to, or correction of, personal data should be made in writing to The Departmental Personal Data Controlling Officer of Agriculture, Fisheries and Conservation Department at 5th Floor, Cheung Sha Wan Government Offices, 303 Cheung Sha Wan Road, Kowloon, Hong Kong.
