

CHINESE MEDICINE ORDINANCE (Chapter 549)

ORDER MADE BY THE CHINESE MEDICINE PRACTITIONERS BOARD OF
THE CHINESE MEDICINE COUNCIL OF HONG KONG

Notice is hereby given that the Chinese Medicine Practitioners Board of the Chinese Medicine Council of Hong Kong, after an inquiry on 28 April 2017 conducted pursuant to section 56(1)(d) of the Chinese Medicine Ordinance (Chapter 549, Laws of Hong Kong), was satisfied that the following acts of CHAN Yik-shek, registered Chinese medicine practitioner (registration no.: 003200) as prescribed under section 56(1)(d) of the Chinese Medicine Ordinance, are proved:—

Since the expiry of his last practising certificate on 31 August 2014, registered Chinese medicine practitioner CHAN Yik-shek, being a person required to be the holder of a practising certificate under section 76 of the Chinese Medicine Ordinance, has continued practising Chinese medicine without obtaining such a certificate for a period exceeding 6 months.

Pursuant to section 56(1)(d) of the Chinese Medicine Ordinance, the Chinese Medicine Practitioners Board decided on 28 April 2017 that, for the above established facts, the name of CHAN Yik-shek be removed from the Register of Chinese Medicine Practitioners with effect from 28 April 2017.
