

## ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

## TEMPORARY RESTRICTED ZONES IN WAN CHAI DISTRICT

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 12.01 a.m. on 29 June 2017 to 11.59 p.m. on 1 July 2017, the following road sections in Wan Chai District will be temporarily designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the southern kerbside lane of Gloucester Road service road from a point about 10 metres east of its junction with Fenwick Street to a point about 65 metres east of the same junction;
- (b) the southern kerbside lane of Gloucester Road service road from a point about 35 metres west of its junction with Fleming Road to a point about 90 metres west of the same junction;
- (c) the southern kerbside lane of Gloucester Road service road from a point about 35 metres east of its junction with Fleming Road to a point about 65 metres east of the same junction;
- (d) the southern kerbside lane of Gloucester Road service road from a point about 70 metres west of its junction with Stewart Road to a point about 100 metres west of the same junction;
- (e) the southern kerbside lane of Gloucester Road service road from a point about 10 metres west of its junction with Tonnochy Road to a point about 75 metres west of the same junction;
- (f) the eastern kerbside lane of Stewart Road from its junction with Jaffe Road to a point about 35 metres north of the same junction;
- (g) the western kerbside lane of Tonnochy Road from its junction with Jaffe Road to a point about 25 metres north of the same junction; and
- (h) the southern kerbside lane of Lockhart Road from a point about 25 metres east of its junction with Fleming Road to a point about 40 metres east of the same junction.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be temporarily rescinded.
