Amendments under section 7

Notice is hereby given that under powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing under section 3(3) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) ('the Ordinance'), the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes to amend the works and the use originally shown on Plans Nos. TK2377 to TK2385 ('the Plans') and described in the scheme annexed thereto, which the Plans and scheme were referred to in G.N. 2569 published under section 8(2) of the Ordinance on 10 May 2013 and 16 May 2013 and were authorized under section 11(2)(b) of the Ordinance and the notice of authorization was published in G.N. 3063 on 30 May 2014 and 6 June 2014. The proposed amendments are shown on Amendment Plans Nos. TK2378A and TK2382A ('the Amendment Plans') and described in the amendment scheme annexed thereto, which the Amendment Plans and amendment scheme have been deposited in the Land Registry.

The general nature and extent of the proposed amendments are as follows:—

- (i) deletion of the two originally proposed vertical noise barriers and an originally proposed cantilever noise barrier at Cha Kwo Ling Road (refer to Amendment Plan No. TK2378A);
- (ii) revision of the original limit of works area near the proposed re-aligned footpath leading to Junk Bay Chinese Permanent Cemetery (refer to Amendment Plan No. TK2382A);
- (iii) temporary closure of a section of the existing footpath (refer to Amendment Plan No. TK2382A); and
- (iv) ancillary works including geotechnical and slope works.
