## ROAD TRAFFIC (TRAFFIC CONTROL) REGULATIONS (Chapter 374)

## RESTRICTED ZONES IN CENTRAL DISTRICT

In exercise of the powers vested in me under regulation 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic (Traffic Control) Regulations, Chapter 374, I hereby direct that with effect from 10.00 a.m. on 6 July 2017, the following road sections will be designated as restricted zones 24 hours daily:—

- (a) the northern kerbside lane of Chater Road between Pedder Street and Ice House Street;
- (b) the eastern kerbside lane of Des Voeux Road Central between Jubilee Street and Queen Victoria Street;
- (c) the western kerbside lane of Des Voeux Road Central between Queen Victoria Street and Jubilee Street;
- (d) the western kerbside lane of Connaught Road Central between Queen Victoria Street and Gilman Street; and
- (e) the western kerbside lane of Connaugth Road central between Pedder Street and Pottinger Street.

Within the restricted zones, drivers of all motor vehicles, except franchised buses and those with permits issued by the Commissioner for Transport, will be prohibited from:—

- (a) picking up or setting down passengers; or
- (b) loading or unloading goods.

The extent of the restricted zones will be indicated by appropriate traffic signs and road markings.

At the same time, the existing restricted zones on the above road sections will be rescinded.
